Suspected Monkeypox (MPX) Case
CDC criteria for suspected and probable MPX cases

- Isolate patient immediately: enhanced droplet & contact precautions
- Notify the following departments IMMEDIATELY:
 - Microbiology (x25538)
 - Infection Prevention (IP) (x25662)
 - Washoe County Health District (775-328-2447) – if afterhours or on weekend
- Collect and transport sample (Dry, non-cotton swab collection and dry sterile transport container) – refer to: MPX testing procedure
 - Results in ~24-72 hours
- Complete patient intake form
 - Email to AntimicrobialStewardship@Renown.org
- Refer patient to CDC Isolation and Prevention Practices for People with Monkeypox

NON-REOWN Provider

Obtain informed consent and send to Antimicrobialstewardship@Renown.org

Prescribes tecovirimat to Pringle Pharmacy 775-982-7737

Instruct provider to search, "How to obtain TPOXX" and follow CDC link /directions to meet EA-IND

Positive Result

Negative Result

Microbiology Laboratory notifies pertinent parties
Provider, IP, ID Pharmacy

Testing Provider or Agent contacts patient to relay negative result

ID Pharmacy (x22193) contacts patient to review informed consent or confirms status

Consent obtained

Consent refused

ID Rx: assess potential exposures
→ follow PEP pathway

Inpatient and outpatient:
ID Pharmacy coordinates dispensing of tecovirimat to patient

Inpatient and outpatient:
No further follow up re: Pharmacotherapy
